Course Description:

This train-the-trainer course is designed to teach the incumbent all the necessary skills to teach the 1402 Single Officer Response Course, in addition to the accompanied 1403 Instructor Course. Class will expose students to stress and moderate physical discomfort due to the dynamic nature of the drills and scenarios.

Course Topics:

- How to set up the courses of fire
- Safety requirements for the exercises
- All the 1402 Training scenarios
- How to train other trainers and effective strategies

Required Equipment:

Students must bring their duty belts and attend in attire that replicates their daily uniform or tactical range attire; to include Duty Vest, Duty Belt, Hat, Range approved Eye and Ear Protection. Please also bring snacks, sunscreen, and water.

200 rounds of standard issued firearm ammunition and 3 magazines will also be needed for each student.
