Social Sciences Full Text. Articles covering anthropology, criminology, economics, geography, international relations, political science, psychology, public administration, sociology, and related fields. 1983+

Academic OneFile. Articles from peer-reviewed sources with coverage of the physical sciences, medicine, social sciences, theology, and other subjects. Transcripts and audio from NPR programs are available.

OmniFile Full Text. Multi-disciplinary meta-database providing text & abstracts from seven Wilson databases. 1800+ titles. Full-text 1995+
