



# Steps to TCC – Dual Enrollment

## ✓ Step 1: Meet Admissions Criteria

Meet with your high school guidance counselor to verify you meet admissions criteria and determine if dual enrollment is right for you.

## ✓ Step 2: Apply to TCC

Apply for admission to TCC using our online application at [www.tcc.fl.edu](http://www.tcc.fl.edu) under “Apply”. Be sure to complete the Application specific to Dual Enrollment.

## ✓ Step 3: Submit test scores

Submit official copies of placement test scores (ACT, SAT, PERT). Private and Home School students may test at the TCC Testing Center.

## ✓ Step 4: Search for courses

Find the courses that are right for you at [www.tcc.fl.edu](http://www.tcc.fl.edu) under “How to Register for Classes”, then submit the Permission to Register form (each semester) and other applicable forms.

## ✓ Step 5: Visit EagleNet

Familiarize yourself with our online portal [EagleNet](#) where you can access your email, student records, degree audit, registration and much more. Be sure to check your [TCC email](#) frequently as that is the College’s official means of communication to students. If you need assistance, visit [Student Central FAQ](#).

## ✓ Step 6: Check for upcoming deadlines

Review the [academic calendar](#) and make note of key important dates, including:

- ✓ First Day of Class
- ✓ Last Day to Add a Class
- ✓ Last Day to Drop a Class
- ✓ Fee Payment Due Date

## ✓ Step 7: Get Books and Supplies
