The BSN is designed for currently licensed Florida registered nurses who have completed an Associate in Science (AS) degree in Nursing (ADN). The curriculum builds on and complements the course work and clinical experiences of the ADN, providing a seamless pathway into the BSN and higher workforce leadership and management positions.

This academic map assumes the student has an Associate of Science (AS) in Nursing and at least 72 hours towards the 120 hours needed to obtain the Bachelor of Science (BSN) degree in Nursing to include the following:
