## Eugene Lamb, Jr.

Eugene Lamb has been a member of the Board of Trustees for TCC since 2007, and has served a Chair of the Board twice. He currently serves a Vice Chair. He brings to the role a deep knowledge, understand and passion for his native Gadsden county. Eugene directly impacted the lives of thousands of students during his more than thirty years as a teacher and coach in Leon, Gadsden and Volusia counties.

Eugene's public service includes eight years as a Gadsden County Commissioner including two years as chair and as a member of the Midway Council where he served as both mayor and mayor pro-tem. In addition, Eugene was appointed by Governor Scott to server on the Florida Commission on Healthcare and Hospital Funding in 2015. Since 2014 Eugene has served as an at-large member of the Board of Directors of the Florida High School Athletic Association, representing Gadsden County.

Eugene graduated from Northside High School in 1965 and was the first player named All-State in basketball from Northside. He earned his Bachelor's Degree in Health and Physical Education from Dillard University in 1971. He was recently inducted into the Gadsden County Sports Hall of Fame.
