Todd Sperry

Todd Sperry's family moved to Tallahassee in 1972. After earning a degree in building construction from the University of Florida in 1983, he joined the family construction business Sperry and Associates. In the mid 1990s he led the formation of two businesses: Commercial Repair and Renovation and Metal Building Services. In 2001 he was recruited by the St. Joe Company to develop a construction division, and in 2007 he led the formation of Oliver Renovation and Construction as well as Kimmel Development Services. Todd's current role is Vice President and CFO of OliverSperry Renovation, but his unofficial title is "Head Schemer and Dreamer".

Todd graduated from Godby High School and to this day, he continues to support his alma mater and its students, especially those seeking to attend TCC. His work with the Godby Alumni Association resulted in the establishment of the Legacy Scholarship. He and his business partner, Bill Oliver, established a scholarship that provides funding to Godby graduates entering TCC. Todd and his wife Jodi also created a scholarship honoring Todd's father—Donald Sperry—for students at TCC studying in the building construction AS degree program.

Todd has always been invested in community service. He chaired the United Way of the big Bend, the Tallahassee Greater Chamber of Commerce, and the Sales Tax Committee. From 2003-2008 he advised Leon County School's Citizen Oversight Committee. He is a Founding member of Sustainable Tallahassee and a member of TCC's Capital Campaign Cabinet 2016. In 2019, Sperry received the Godfrey Smith Past Award.

Todd has been a part of two businesses that have been selected 'Small Business of the Year' by the Chamber: Sperry & Associates in 2000 and OliverSperry Renovation in 2016. Todd and his wife Jodi, of 35 years, have a son and a daughter.
