## MEMORANDUM

**SUBJECT:** Grants and Contracts - TCC as Provider

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### Item Description:

This item requests that the Board approve the receipt of funding for the listed projects.

### Overview:

The following are recommended for approval:

#### I. RECEIPT, AMENDMENT, EXTENSION OF RESOURCES

##### Take Stock In Children / College Reach Out Program (CROP)

This is a renewal award enhancing CROP's outreach efforts in Gadsden, Leon and Wakulla counties. CROP's primary goal is to work with individuals from grades 6-12 to increase the number of potential first generation-in-college students who successfully receive a college education. The amount of this award is \$90,732.00, with an indirect cost rate of 0%. The funding period is from 7/1/2010 through 6/30/2011.

##### Florida Department of Education – College Reach Out Program (CROP)

This award is to provide funding for partners in the Panhandle CROP Consortium in support of their continuing outreach and postsecondary recruitment efforts for low-income and educationally disadvantaged middle and high school students. The five postsecondary education consortium partners are Chipola College, Flagler College, Florida A&M University, Gulf Coast Community College and Tallahassee Community College. This award is \$242,652.08, with an indirect cost rate of 0%. The funding period is from 9/1/2010 – 8/31/2011.

##### Florida Department of Law Enforcement – PTLEA Region III Trust Award

This award will provide CJSTC approved advanced and specialized training courses through Florida Public Safety Institute for local law enforcement officers. The amount of the award is \$92,125.00, with an indirect cost rate of 5%. The funding period is from 7/1/2010 through 6/30/2011.

##### Florida Department of Law Enforcement – PTLEA Region XV Trust Award

This award will provide CJSTC approved advanced and specialized training courses through Florida Public Safety Institute for state law enforcement officers. The amount of the award is \$255,471.00, with an indirect cost rate of 5%. The funding period is from 7/1/2010 through 6/30/2011.

**Salient Facts:**

The Board of Trustees has authority to contract with outside agencies for provider management.

**Past Actions:**

There has been no previous action by the Board on this funding.

**Future Actions:**

No further activity on the part of the Board is necessary.

**Funding/Financial Matters:**

The above projects will be established in a Fund 2, Restricted Accounts. The indirect earned from these awards will be \$16,552.19.
