- Since 2018, TCC has nearly doubled the number of students accepted into Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) and Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree programs in order to meet local demand.
- The nursing program is ranked #7 in the US by Registerednurse.org.
- 90% of the students enrolled in the workforce healthcare programs received an employer-sponsored scholarship or other support such as CARES emergency aid grant.
