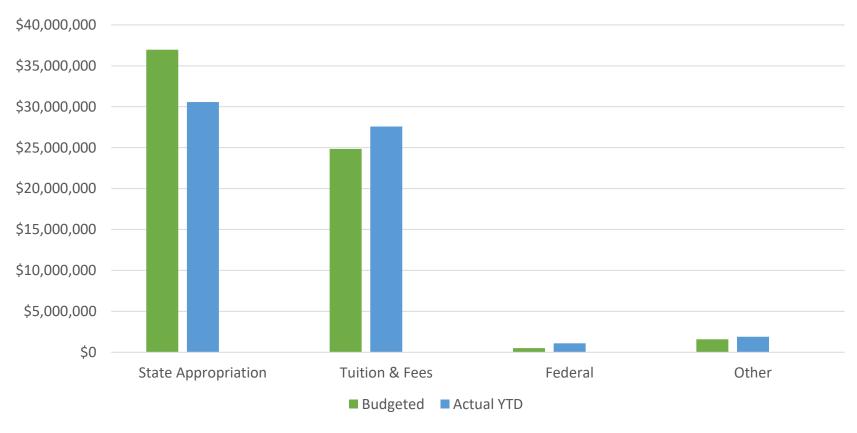

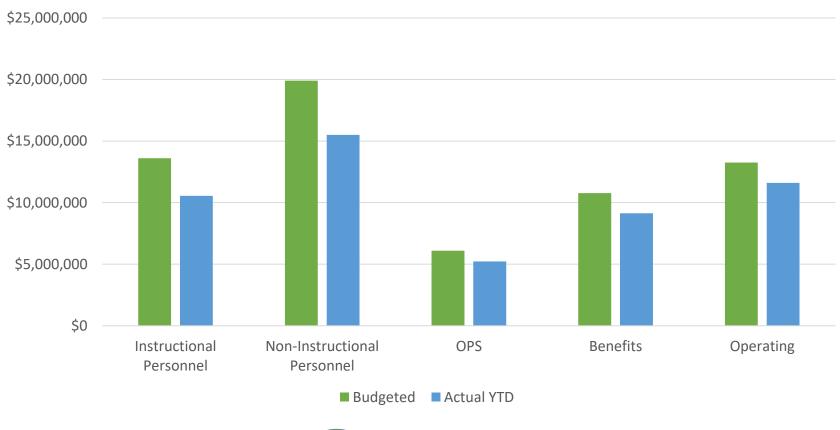


#### Revenue - Budget & YTD



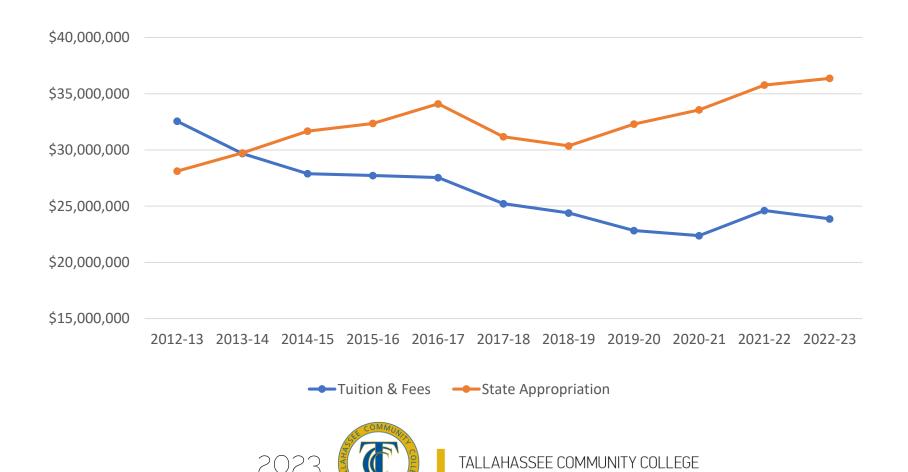


#### Expenditures - Budget & YTD

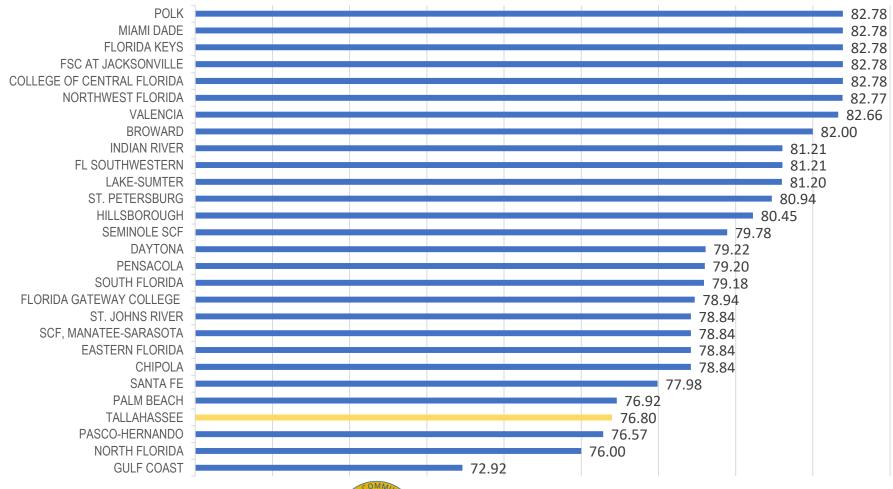


#### Student Full Time Equivalent

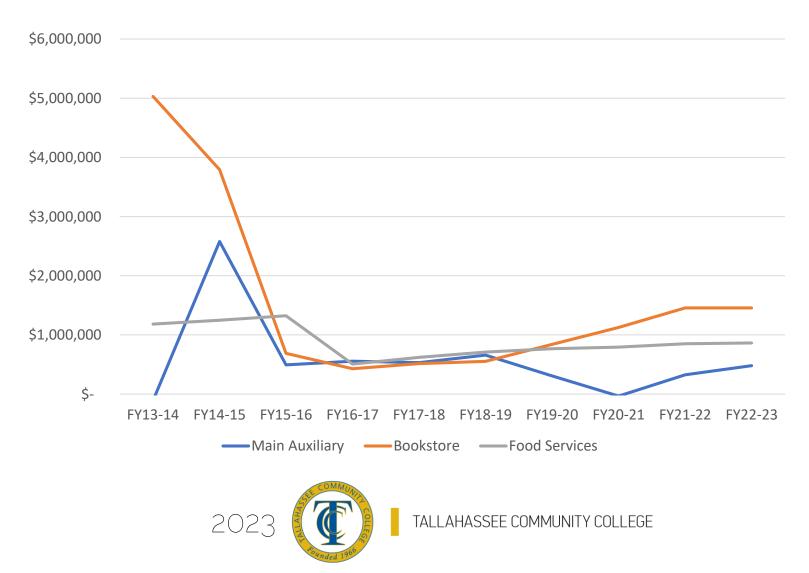




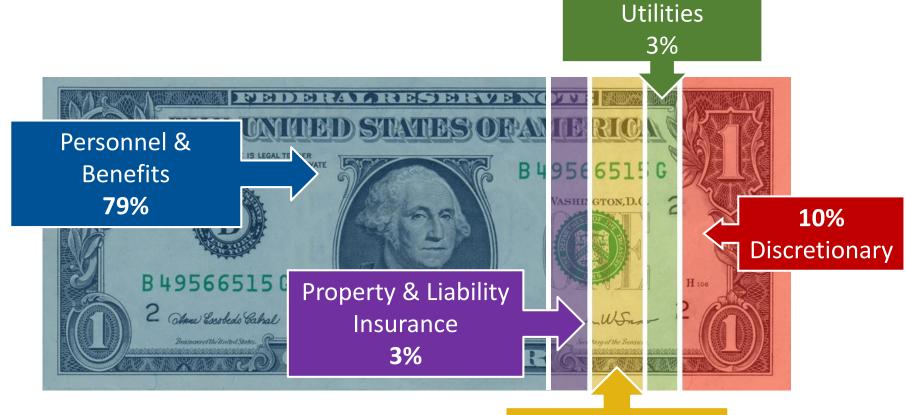

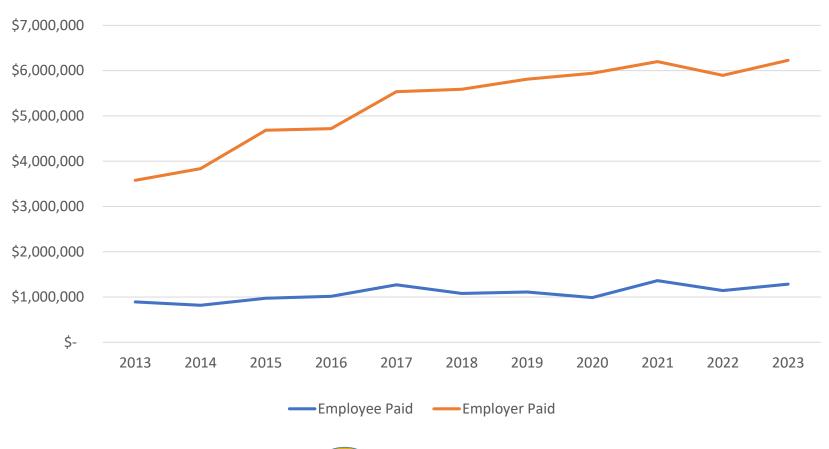




Increased Costs for Fiscal Year 2024

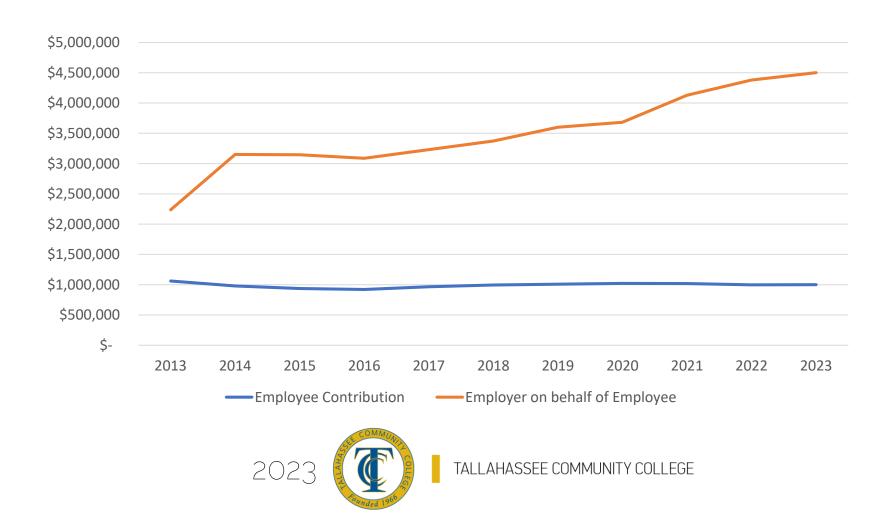


#### Health Insurance Costs

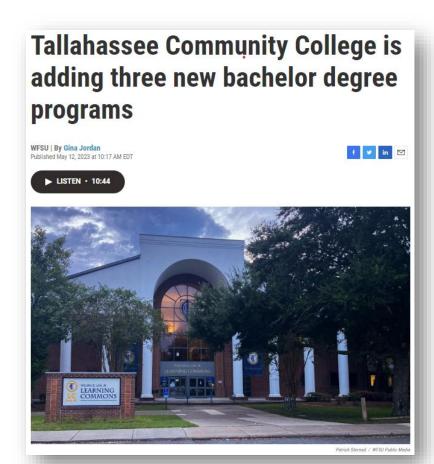
