# Item Description:

Staff is requesting changes to Board approved laboratory fees for law enforcement and corrections programs offered at the Florida Public Safety Institute.

#### Salient Facts:

Staff has been able to negotiate for a savings in instructional materials provided students by placing bulk orders for materials in partnership with other Florida training centers. That savings is indicated in the proposed reduction of fees for most of the courses listed above from \$15.00 to \$10.00. In other cases, increasing costs have resulted in the need to propose increased fees. Specifically, in the areas of vehicle operations and firearms proposed fee increases will provide for increases in gasoline and ammunition costs to the Institute. The increase in the physical fitness fee is the result of a decision to partner with fitness professionals to provide the equipment and supplies required for testing and instruction during the academies.

### Past Actions:

Recommendations for fee adjustments are made annually by staff.

#### Future Actions:

Each year, staff will review laboratory fees and make recommendations to the Board.

## Funding/Financial Matters:

The net effect of these proposed laboratory fee adjustments for law enforcement recruits will be a \$40.00 increase. The net effect of these proposed adjustments for corrections recruits will be a \$10.00 increase.
