Pursuant to Section 1004.70 FS, the District Board of Trustees is authorized to certify not-for-profit Florida corporations as direct-support organizations (DSO) operating in a manner consistent with the goals of the College and in the best interest of the state. The President of the College is authorized to implement procedures and guidelines appropriate to allow the direct-support organization the use of property, facilities, and personnel subject to the provisions of Section 1004.70 FS. The President or designee must approve any DSO Board action that may obligate resources of the College.

The DSOs are governed by Boards of Directors, which are responsible for setting policies related to the operation of the DSO. The Chair of the Board of Trustees shall appoint a representative to the Board of Directors and the Executive Committee of each direct-support organization. The president or the president's designee shall serve on the Board of Directors and the Executive Committee of each direct-support organization.

Each DSO shall provide full, complete, and timely information to the District Board of Trustees, as required by Section 1004.70 FS.
