<p>Hazardous Condition</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p>“Attention. Attention. Hazardous condition. Seek shelter immediately and wait for the all clear.”</p> <p>What You should do: FERP Reference: Shelter in Place</p>
<p>Severe Weather</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p>“Attention. Attention. This is an emergency. Severe weather approaching. Seek shelter immediately.”</p> <p>What You should do: FERP Reference: Severe Weather</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">General Emergency</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p style="text-align: center;">"Public Safety Emergency. Please take shelter immediately. Seek additional information from the Campus emergency information network."</p> <p>What You should do: FERP Reference: Shelter in Place</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Hazardous Material Release</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p style="text-align: center;">“Attention. Life threatening situation. A hazardous material release has occurred. Go inside. Close all windows and doors. Stay until further notice.”</p> <p>What You should do: FERP Reference: Hazardous Material Spill and Shelter in Place</p>

<p>Dangerous Situation</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p>“Attention. Dangerous situation reported on campus. Take cover and stay in place until further information is provided. Repeat. Take cover and stay in place until further notice.”</p> <p>What You should do: FERP Reference: Shelter in Place</p>
<p>Dangerous Person</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p>“Attention! Armed and dangerous person alert. Seek a secure location.”</p> <p>What You should do: FERP Reference: Dangerous / Disruptive Persons Shelter in Place</p>
<p>Lightning</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p>Dangerous lightning in the area. Take shelter immediately. Repeat, dangerous lightning in the area. Take shelter immediately.</p> <p>What You should do: FERP Reference: Severe Weather Shelter in Place</p>

<p align="center">Shelter</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p align="center">“Public safety notice. Please take shelter immediately and wait for further instructions.”</p> <p>What You should do: FERP Reference: Shelter in Place</p>
<p align="center">Evacuation</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p align="center">“Warning, this is a campus evacuation order. Repeat, this is a campus evacuation order. Remain calm and leave campus immediately.”</p> <p>What You should do: FERP Reference: Evacuation - Onsite</p>
<p align="center">All Clear</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p align="center">“Attention! Attention! This is the all clear. TCC is open and operating under normal conditions.”</p> <p>What You should do: No Action Required Return To Normal Operations</p>
<p align="center">Test</p>	<p>What you will Hear....</p> <p align="center">TCC alert. “TCC is conducting a test of the emergency notification system. This is only a test.”</p> <p>What You should do: No Action Required Continue Normal Operations</p>
