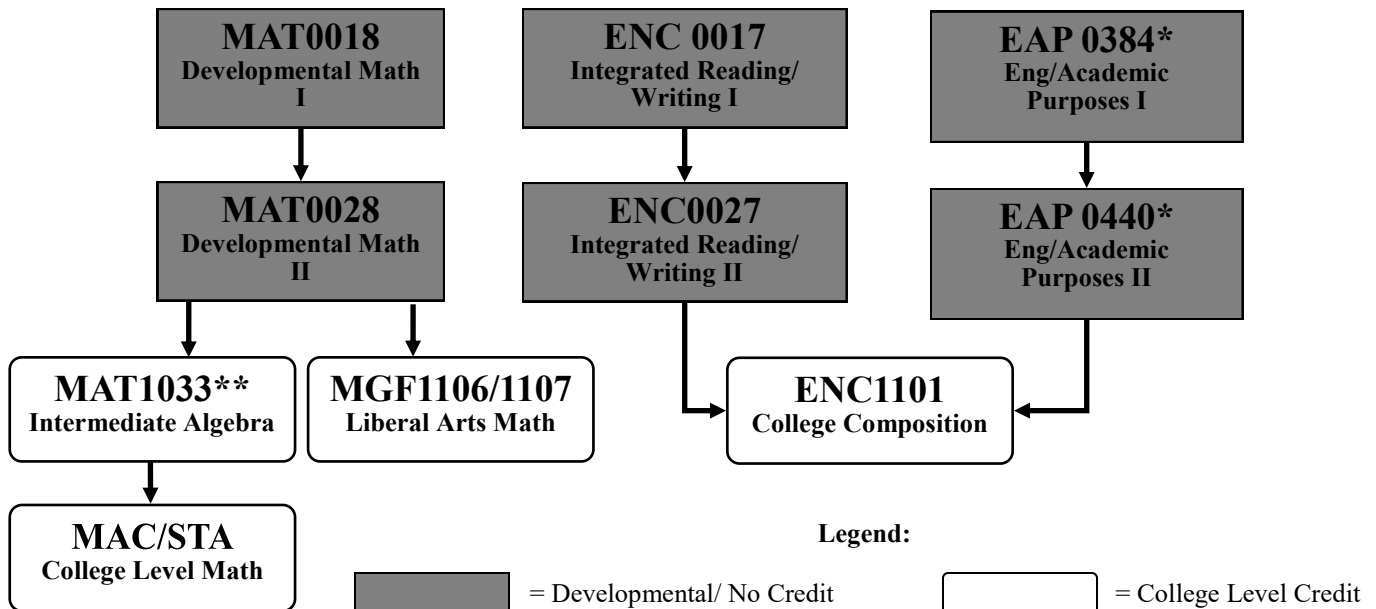
Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT) FAQ's

Congratulations! You have completed another important step in the Tallahassee Community College enrollment process. In an effort to answer any questions regarding your PERT results and your next step in the enrollment process, please read the following Frequently Asked Questions. Q: What do my PERT results mean?

A:

On your PERT test results page under the heading of 'Courses', you will see your advised level for the Communications and Mathematics areas. Find your advised course for each academic area in the flowchart below. By following this flowchart, you can see the academic progression needed for each academic area.



***Students whose primary language is not English, will follow the EAP sequence (EAP0384 instead of ENC0017 and EAP0440 instead of ENC0027).**
**** MAT1033 does not grant College Level Math credit, it is considered as an elective credit course.**

Q: Am I required to take the classes indicated on my PERT test results sheet?



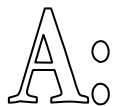
Yes. You must take the sequence of courses your test results indicate. You may however provide other test results or retake the PERT but must take courses based on current test results at the time of registration. Remember, developmental courses, indicated in the grey squares above, do not count as credit(s) toward your academic program. Any courses listed in the white boxes count for college credit and may be applied to your program of study.

Q: If I am unhappy with my PERT test results, can I retake the PERT?



Your test scores are valid for 2 years (unless you opt to retest after 14 days). *Students may take the PERT as often as they like but must wait 14 days between each attempt.*

Q: Can I use other test scores?



Accuplacer, ACT or SAT scores that are less than two years old and PERT scores less than two years old taken at other Florida institutions may be provided to TCC's Testing Office. The ACT and/or SAT scores below allow advisement for college level courses.
