Quality of Research	Exemplifies robust and rigorous research on an innovative topic that is developed with rigor, substance, and depth	Includes sufficient research of some substance and depth but could have been more rigorous and complete	The research is not entirely sufficient to meet the scope of the project and lacks the depth and rigor appropriate for its scope	The research is superficial and of limited depth with minimal substance or evident rigor	
Synthesis and/or Conclusions	Synthesizes information and/or data and draws conclusions to assemble a body of knowledge that is unique, transformative, and original	Adequate synthesis of information and/or data is evident, and the project exhibits originality in assembling information from various sources	Some synthesis of information and/or data is observed, though the project does not communicate a message that is thoroughly original and unique	The project consists of a listing of information and/or data from various sources and a presentation that is neither unique nor original
