SUBJECT: Construction Status Report

Item Description

This item describes the status of various construction, renovation, remodeling and site improvement projects at Tallahassee Community College locations for information for the Board of Trustees.

Overview and Background

Main Campus: Preliminary work has commenced to update the campus master plans for Main Campus and the Florida Public Safety Institute. Feasibility studies for the former Hood and Gorman buildings, the Lifetime Sports Center, and new entrance canopies at several campus buildings are nearing completion.

Wakulla Environmental Institute: At this writing, the U.S. Economic Development Administration continues to review TCC's information submittal.

Florida Public Safety Institute: Engineering design continues for the remediation of the earthen berm behind the firing range and related stormwater treatment areas. Design work is anticipated to be complete in February and will go out for pricing in March.

Gadsden Center: Since the Construction Manager for this project is not yet on board, the design team has had the opportunity to further refine the building plan for greater efficiency. Construction document completion has moved to the end of January.
