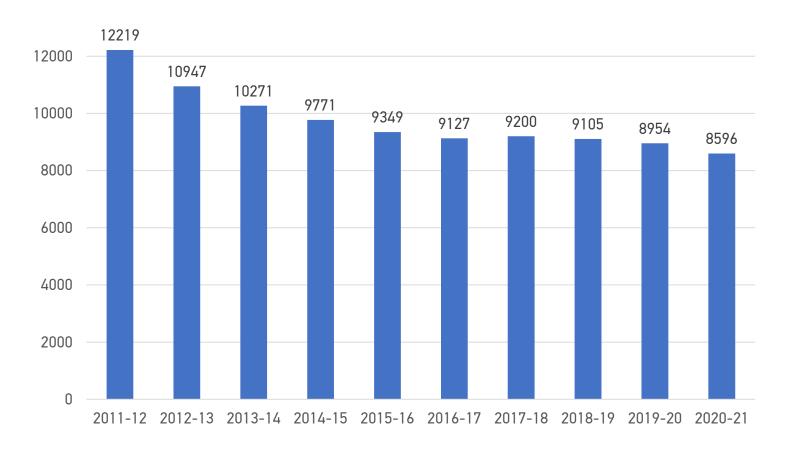

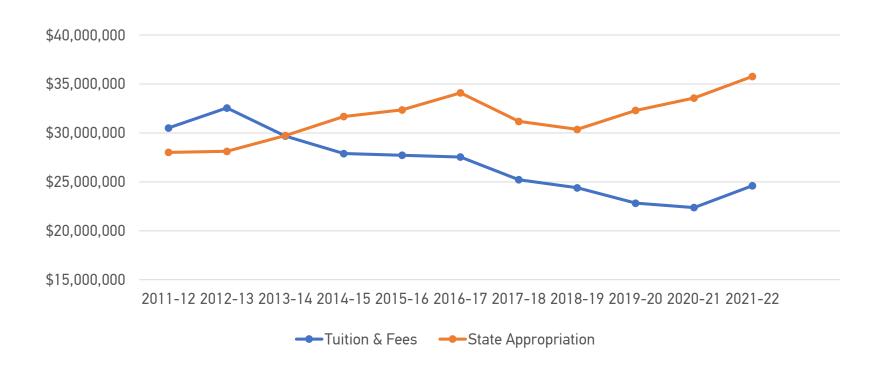


Student Full Time Equivalent



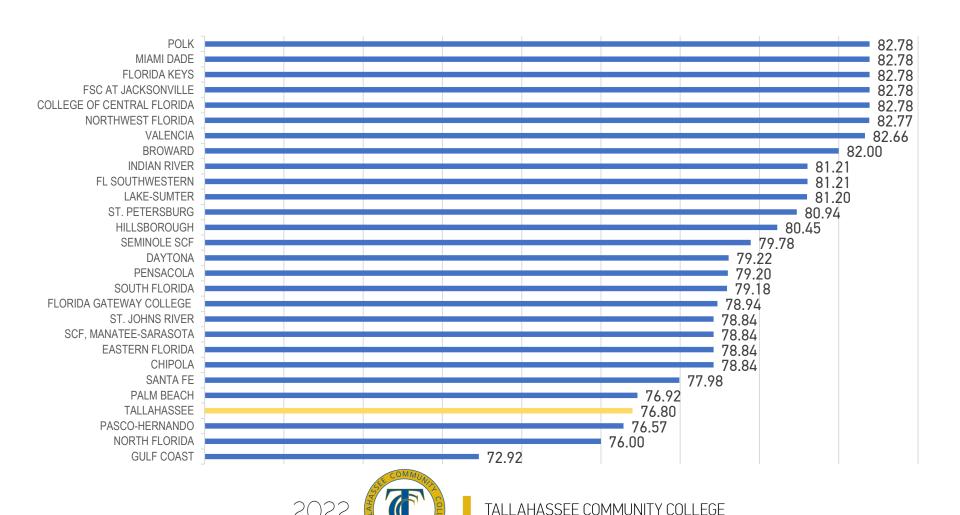


College Revenue





FCS Tuition

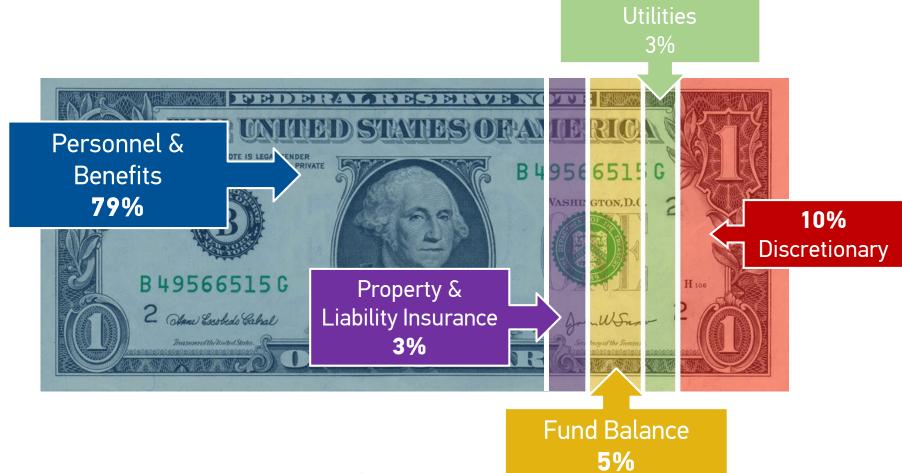


Fund 3 Auxiliary Accounts

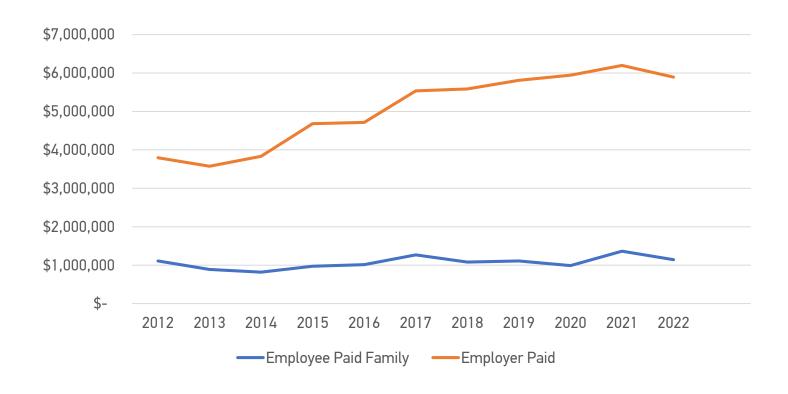

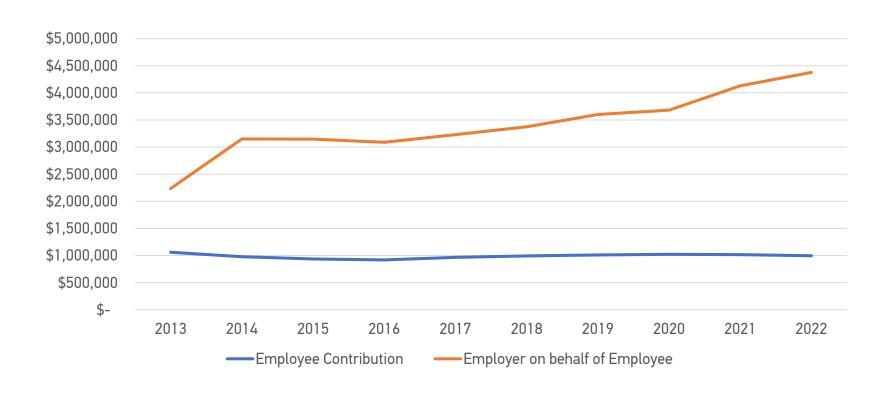
