

## Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Institutional Reporting (1st Quarter)

Tallahassee Community College (Agency) has been awarded \$7,763,584 under the CARES Act. It is our goal to support the College, reach as many students as possible, and comply with all U.S. Department of Education guidelines. Fifty-percent (\$3,881,792) of those funds are to provided to support any costs associated with significant changes to the delivery of instruction due to the coronavirus, including additional aid to students. The other fifty-percent is restricted to student support.

Additionally, the College was awarded \$379,807, under the CARES Act Strengthening Institutions Program whose purpose mirror the institutional funding restrictions. Funds have not been expended at this time.

## For the period of 5/4/2020 - 6/30/2020:
